What appointments will be scheduled for an adult ADHD assessment?

- 1. Intake session (50 minutes)
- 2. Testing session #1 (120 minutes)
- 3. Testing session #2 (120 minutes)
- 4. Report feedback session (30 minutes *optional service*)

What happens after the adult ADHD assessment is completed?

All findings are presented to the client in a comprehensive psychologist report that will consider all potential explanations for ADHD-like presentations including (but not limited to): specific learning disorders, intellectual disability or giftedness, other behavioural disorders, and mental health/trauma history.
